Club Rules

Club Hours Mon-Fri 8am to dusk Weekends & Holidays 9am to dusk

General

- No alcohol is allowed on the premises
- Everyone is responsible for knowing safe gun handling procedures and the range rules for each range they shoot on.
- Clean up all your trash and all your brass or lose your membership. There is no excuse for walking away and leaving a mess for someone else to clean up.
- The club is a volunteer organization, we have no paid staff. Each member is expected to do their fair share in the clean-up, maintenance and operation of the club.

Membership and Guests

- The membership year begins at the annual meeting, held the first Tuesday in May. Do your best to send in your check and renewal for in advance of the annual meeting so you can pick up your membership card with lock combination at the meeting. This saves work for our secretary and the expense of mailing membership cards.
- Members in good standing receive a combination to the gate, good from the evening of the annual meeting to the following annual meeting date.
- Giving the combination to a non-member is grounds for immediate termination of your membership.
- You may bring one non-member guest at a time to shoot. Any individual may be your guest up to two times, but must join the club after that.
- Members immediate family are considered associate members. There is no limit on the number of times associate members may shoot but the member must accompany them to the range each time they shoot.
- Any club member may ask to see the membership card of anyone shooting on the ranges and members are required to show their membership card if asked.
- All members are urged to advise club officers of violators of club rules. Violators will be brought before the Board of Directors
- No minors allowed on club property unless accompanied by an adult member.

Gate Combination

- When club events are ongoing, the gate will be open and the lock will not be present. If you enter the club when the gate is open, be aware that the gate may be locked when you leave. Don't get locked in, have your combination with you!
- At any time other than organized club events, the gate must be kept closed and locked. Lock it immediately after you pass through, don't leave it open for someone arriving later.
- If you do not know a person driving in behind you, ask to see their membership card before you allow them to pass through a gate you have unlocked.
- Do not give out combination. This is grounds for immediate suspension.
